

Abbotswood Primary School Homework – Term 1

Tasks I must complete each week: Phanics

Number Bands

Your child should be reading at least 4 times a week.
This can be their school reading

Reading

book, library book or a book of interest to them.

All reading book and records should come in to school EVERY FRIDAY.

All children have been put into groups that match their current attainment.

We assess the children every six weeks (quicker if we feel they have made accelerated progress) and match their phonics groups accordingly.

Alongside phonics, children also learn a range of common exception words that they should be able to read and spell by the end of Year I.

Children will be sent home with a list of common exception words each term that we would like them to learn.



Children are expected to have instant recall of number bonds to 5, 10 and 20 by the end of Year 1.

Please can you practise these bonds at home, securing knowledge and understanding. This can initially be done by using resources (fingers are a great help as they are always with them!) then moving onto instant recall.
