To answer this question we will be historians, scientists and engineers as we explore how Brunel changed our local area as well as further afield. We are going to look particularly as bridges and tunnels to discover the impact that Brunel had on our travel. Our final challenge will be to create a poster of one of Brunel's inventions and present a convincing argument for why it was his most significant.
