# Tasks I must complete each week:

## Reading

## As an athlete:

Get moving! Whether it's going on a small walk, jumping on a trampoline or playing at the park, get a bit of exercise and move about.



### As a scientist:

Research the things you can see that move at home, outside and in your local area. Make a list or poster to show them.



# As an engineer:

Create a moving split pin animal. Think about what parts of it move: legs, tail, mouth, etc.



## As an author:

Find books with moving parts (flap, pop-ups, levers and sliders). Perhaps visit the library to find some new ones.
