

This term in Year 1

We hope you all had a fantastic half term and managed to avoid the rain. This term we have gone whole class maths—the children are getting on fabulously and are becoming more independent in their learning. We have also have our trip booked for this term—Noah's Ark Farm Zoo on Tuesday 1st April.

Maths

As **mathematicians** we will be learning about place value to 20 and looking at the value of each digit in a number. We will also be learning to compare numbers (using Blockzee) and ordering numbers from smallest to greatest. Furthermore, we will be adding a single digit number to a two-digit number and subtracting a single digit number from a two-digit number.



English

As **writers** we will be looking at the book 'The Night Pirates' written by Peter Harris. The children will be learning how to build a sentence, use 'and' in a list and add 'ing' to the root word to change the meaning. The children will also be reading 'Jack and the Incredibly Mean Stalk' and 'Billy and the Beast'.



Enquiry



Our first enquiry question this term is 'How do we move around?' As **scientists and engineers**, we will be investigating books with moving parts and thinking about how books can be made more interesting. Additionally, the children will become **artists** to explore 'What is my school like in spring?'

RE



As **philosophers** we will be exploring how and why we celebrate sacred times..

Children will be learning the basics of coding, which is the process of giving instructions to a computer to make it perform tasks.

PE
