Maths

As **mathematicians** this term we will be beginning with Fractions of shape and number.

Later on in the term we will be moving on to look at telling the time. This is such a key life skill and needs the support at home too. We will be learning o'clock, half past and quarter to and past.



English

We have two quality texts for this term: 'The Day The Crayons Quit' by Oliver Jeffers and 'The Secret of Black Rock' – Joe Todd-Stanton. As writers we will be using these texts to inspire writing for different purposes including letters, instructions and

Our first enquiry this term looks at the question 'How do plants grow near us?'. We will explore this as scientists and geographers. As geographers we will be looking at our school environment as well as further afield, thinking about how plants survive in various climates, including oceans and around the world. As scientists we will be thinking about what a plant needs to survive, planting our own seeds to watch them grow and test out conditions that be suit their growth.



Our second enquiry this term looks at the question 'What is home?', exploring animal habitats and food chains. This enquiry we will be scientists, geographers and historians.
