Tasks I must complete each week:

Reading

Your child should be reading their schoolbook at **least 4** times a week.

Remember to also read books of interest to them to keep them excited about stories.

All reading books and records should come in to school **EVERY FRIDAY**.



Phonics

Children have a list of common exception words each term that we would like them to learn. Please practise the **Term 6 common exception words** as well as the words that they struggled with from earlier terms.

Keep practising for the Phonics Screening Check. This will take place the second week of this term.



Number Bonds

Children are expected to have instant recall of number bonds to **5, 10 and 20** by the end of Year 1. Children who have completed these, will move on to finding half and number doubles.

Please can you practise these bonds at home, securing knowledge and understanding. This can initially be done by using resources (fingers are a great help as they are always with them!) then moving onto instant recall.



This term, I can choose to do:

As an athlete:

Get moving! This term we be practising for sports day and learning how to play the game rounders. Get the family together and play a game.....practise how to take turns!



As an artist:

Create a piece of art inspired by **Romero Britto**. Create a pattern and use bright, bold colours to decorate it.



As an author:

Let your imagination run wild and write a short story about any of the characters we have been introduced to over the whole year! Remember, a story must have a **beginning, a middle and an end**.



As a mathematician:

Look at some coins and learn their value. How many ways can you make 20p?
