Term 6 in Year 1

Maths

As mathematicians we will be learning how to share objects equally. We will also be looking at fractions—find half of a shape and quantity and finding a quarter of a shape and quantity. Furthermore, we will be looking at coins and different denominations, followed by telling the time to the o'clock and half past.



English

As writers we will be exploring FIVE quality texts this term; Kevin, The Lumberjacks Beard, The Dinosaur Next Door, The Panda who Promised and The Storm Whale.

Through a series of mini write, we'll be teaching the Y1 spelling patterns and encouraging children to apply previously taught skills with increasing independence. We will be slowly reducing the amount of adult support, ready for Year 2.



Enquiry

Our enquiry questions for this term are: 'What is Abbotswood like in Spring and Summer?' This Enquiry is an artist based Enquiry, where the children will be exploring different mediums to create a fantastic final piece of art inspired by Romero Britto. They will then become scientists and ask the questions 'What grows near me?'. The children will not only be exploring the outside area, but will also be looking at the life cycle of a plant. The children will be planning seeds as part of this enquiry.
