Reading

Your child should be reading at least 4 times a week. This can be their school reading book, library book or a book of interest to them. All reading book and records should come in to school EVERY FRIDAY.



Spelling

All children have been put into groups that match their current attainment. Those who receive phonics teaching will be given a phonics task. Children who are in one of the spelling groups will need to access their group spelling on the class page on the school website. Spelling should be practised 5 times a week to help your child learn them.
