Maths

Enquiry



This term, in enquiry, we will be historians looking at chronology and we will be curators of our own museums. The children will be creating their own sources as artists. This will answer our new enquiry: 'How can we find out about people in the past?'

The children will learn how historians find out about the past using a range of primary and secondary sources.



RE
