# This term in Year 3

#### Why did people travel in the past? How can you feel the force?

### **Maths**

We will be working on statistics, shape and time this term.

Statistics will build on our knowledge of tallies progressing to pictograms, bar charts and tables. Shape will look at angles and turns, properties of shapes (using words—vertices, edges and faces) and using the key vocabulary; parallel, perpendicular, horizontal and vertical. Time will focus on reading analogue time to the nearest minute and using timelines to solve problems. Please support your child in telling the time as it helps them in lesson—Time is tricky, so please encourage your child wear their watches!



## **English**

In English, we will be using the book 'The Thames and Tide Club' by Katya Balen, and will then move onto the video clip 'Soar.'

We will be focusing on using our non-negotiables in all



of our writing. The children will be perfecting their setting descriptions, using apostrophes for possession and speech in their writing.

We love reading the children's story writing and can't wait to read their stories and pass them onto their next teachers too!

# **Enquiry**



This term, as historians, we will be learning about, 'Why did people travel in the past?' We will be historians and musicians. We will focus on some voyages taken during the Tudor times.

Then, in science, we will be focusing on forces and Magnets. Finishing with our enquiry titled 'How do you feel the force?'
