



Tasks I must complete each week:

Reading

Reading records will be checked every Friday. We ask that the children read a minimum of 4 times per week. In Year 6, the children can read independently (if you would like them to) but we do ask that each read is signed off by an adult.

Spelling

In Year 6, our scheme of work focuses on a spelling rule per week.

The rules should support children in understanding and applying patterns when spelling.

Please see the separate spelling list to see which spelling rules we will be focussing on in class, along with a list of words which follow each rule.

Maths

Please **continue to practise times tables at home**, as this is a vital skill across all areas of maths. Times table tests will be every Friday and the children will be asked to take their results home.

Every week, the children will be assigned questions on **maths.co.uk** to complete. These assignments cover different areas of the Key Stage Two curriculum, in preparation for SATs in term 5. Each child will be assigned their own login.

Additionally, we highly recommend [mathsbot.com](https://www.mathsbot.com) for arithmetic practise. It is free, no log in is required. Please choose the KS2 arithmetic assessment activities when on the website.

SPaG

Every week, the children will be assigned questions on **spag.com** to complete by the following Friday. The questions will be linked to the current punctuation/grammar being taught in class, or revising past key punctuation/grammar skills. Each child will be assigned their own login.
