Maths

This term, we will focusing on projects in our mathematics! We will keep using our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills, whilst working with 'real-life' contexts. English

In English, this term, we will be exploring the world in Harry Potter and basing our creative writing from this. We will write a range of texts, including descriptions of the school and its grounds, the mysteries of Diagon Alley and even create our own potions!



Enquiry—How have sporting events changed over time?

During this enquiry, we will become athletes and historians, focusing on the ancient Greeks and how they have influenced aspects of our modern day lives, in particular...The Olympics!

We will start our enquiry by learning about life in ancient Greece. Once we have developed our understanding of this, we shall begin our research into the very first ancient games! By examining many different sources – such as pottery, statues and ancient writings – we will uncover clues as to what the original Olympics would have been like.

Additionally, we will be learning all about **why** the games were invented and how they became more inclusive over time! Finally, we will end our historical journey by comparing the ancient Greek's Olympics to today's, in preparation for our challenge: hosting a Mini-Olympics!
