Maths

We will be thinking about describing settings and characters and varying our sentence structures.

For this enquiry, we will become historians. We will begin looking at the Anglo-Saxons and then moving onto looking at the Vikings. As we do, we will explore the reasons they came to Britain, the way that they lived, the choices they made and how they worked together and against each other.

We will then finish our Enquiry by becoming artists and making clay-heads to replicate Alfred the Great.
