### Maths

As Mathematicians, we will be developing our arithmetic skills. We will complete our learning of formal methods for addition and subtraction, before moving on to multiplication and division.

### English

As Authors, we will be enhancing our Year 2 skills and learning new Year 3 skills through a range of books.

We will be looking at 'Tin Forest' by Helen Ward and Wayne Anderson and 'The Christmas Pine' by Julia Donaldson.

### Enquiry



As historians, we will explore chronology and investigate our enquiry question: "How can we find out about people in the past?" The children will learn how historians discover information using a range of different sources.

As artists, we will create our own sources and curate our own mini-museums to showcase what we have learned.
