Maths

As **Mathematicians** this term we will be continuing learning all about money. We will then be move on to learning how to multiply and divide.

English

As **writers** we will be looking at the book 'Penguin Huddle' by Ross Montgomery and 'The day the crayons quit' by Drew Daywalt.

Through these texts, we will be learning how to use contractions, commands, and imperative verbs. The children will also be learning the spelling rules for adding suffixes to root words.



Enquiry
